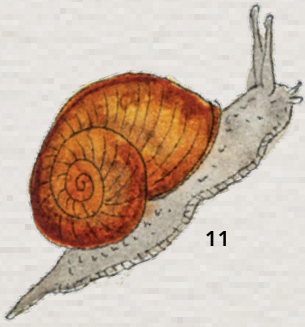


Schoolyard Creatures

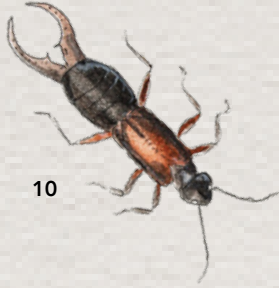

1. TRANVERSE LADYBIRD

They eat tiny insects that often damage veggie patches

2. HONEY BEE

Bees carry pollen on their legs in a Pollen Basket

3. MILLIPEDES

Emerge after rain in big numbers

4. SUGAR ANT

They walk in lines because they follow smells put out by other ants

5. CHRISTMAS BEETLE LARVAE

The larvae will turn into a shiny green, yellowish beetle

6. EARTHWORM

Worms don't have eyes. Their head is where the thick band is (clitellum)

7. PAINTED LADY

Appear in Spring and Autumn

8. WOLF SPIDER

Can bite. Rarely builds a web

9. SLATER

Can roll into a ball to protect themselves

10. EARWIG

They don't have venom but they can pinch you with their 'forceps'

11. GARDEN SNAIL

Snails hibernate in winter and over dry periods by sealing their shell



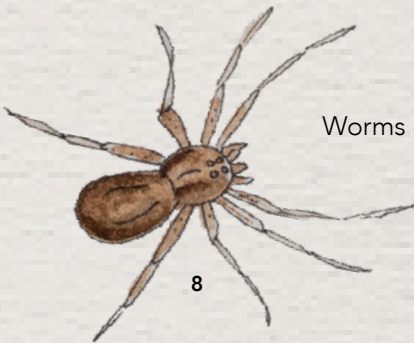

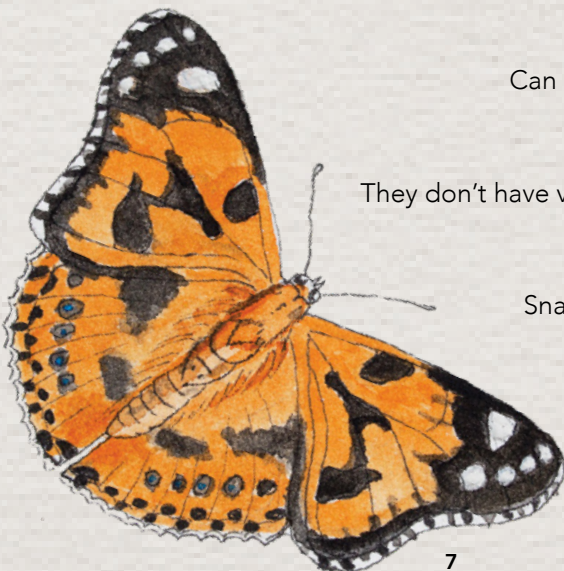

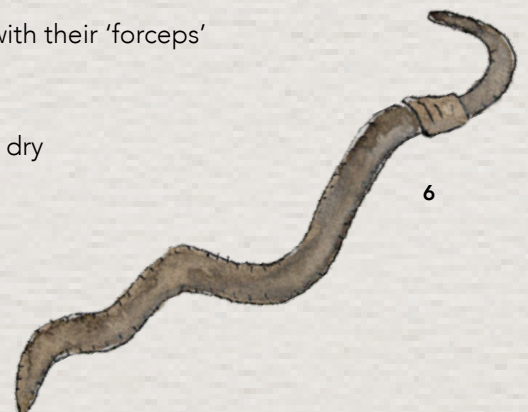
