WHAT IS NATURE PLAY SA COLLECTIVE?

The Nature Play SA Collective is a membership program for educators and families across South Australia. Memberships support the work of Nature Play SA – a not-for-profit organisation dedicated to increasing the amount of time children spends playing and learning outdoors.

WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF THE EDUCATORS MEMBERSHIP TO YOUR SITES?

If you are a site that understands the importance of nature play and the value of outdoor learning environments for children's development and wellbeing, the Educators Membership will benefit your Primary School. It offers a unique online toolkit that aims to build the knowledge, skills, and confidence of leaders and educators on nature play theory, practice and pedagogy.

Benefits include:

- A twelve month subscription to an online portal featuring a database of research, policies, reports, curriculum resources, videos, podcasts, and whole host of new member-specific downloads such as Lesson Plans for primary years and a poster series for Early Years (two updates per year)
- A twelve month subscription to our online magazine Nature Play the Education Way featuring leaders, childhood experts, research, and stories from educators in the field (two per year)
- A 10% discount off all workshops, conferences, incursions and excursion and the opportunity to purchase pre-sale tickets

WHAT DOES A DUAL MEMBERSHIP MEAN?

A Dual Membership applies in circumstances where two sites share the same campus/facility. For example a primary school that shares premises with an early years site is eligible. The dual membership recognises the importance of communication and collaboration between these types of sites is paramount to a shared vision to get more children interacting in outdoor learning environments.

It does apply to OSHC (see OSHC category of membership) or third party sites that use the facility or sites that do not share the same campus/facility.

WHO CAN USE THE MEMBERSHIP WITHIN DUAL SITE?

All the staff within the school can use and access the membership benefits via a shared login provided (password will be set upon registration). In the portal you will find a range of resources and our online magazine featuring contributions from a range of leaders, experts, and practitioners.

CAN OTHER SITES BEYOND THE DUAL MEMBERSHIP USE YOUR LOGIN INFORMATION?

As we are a not-for-profit organisation, the funds generated from our membership provide important financial backing for us to continue; therefore we encourage other sites to support us by financially committing to a category of membership that suits them. We ask that only staff within your dual sites have access to your login information for this reason.

HOW LONG DOES A MEMBERSHIP LAST?

Your membership will be for 12 months from the day of your registration. Renewal reminders will be sent to provide you with the option of re-registering for a further 12 months.

WHAT IS THE METHOD OF PAYMENT?

Your membership is to be paid in full online via credit card or paypal by a nominated person. We do not provide options for split payments and determining the shared costing process is the responsibility of the dual sites.
