Natural materials strongly support children's sense of well-being and agency during play. It provides an unstructured and multi-sensory play experiences whilst honing fine motor skills; developing self-mastery; and supporting each other's efforts collaboratively - all immensely valuable to a child's sense of belonging and self-worth.
