

# School and Class Excursions with Nature Play SA

## Glenthorne National Park – Ityamaitpinna Yarta

Nature Play SA offers a unique range of experiences in Glenthorne National Park – Ityamaitpinna Yarta that sees learners explore Kurna and European history, discover unique flora and fauna, engage in experiences centred around connection, wellbeing, and stewardship. Offerings can also be tailored for any age, ranging from 90-minute programs to full-day events. Afterward, stay to explore the incredible adventure playground.



### Discover Glenthorne National Park – Ityamaitpinna Yarta

This excursion creates meaningful connections to the past, present, and future of the park through rich storytelling. Students learn about the park's history, unique flora and fauna, and contribute to its future through conservation initiatives. Activities include waterbug testing (macroinvertebrates), a biodiversity and history walk, and creative art activities.

**Duration:** 3.5 – 4 hours

**Cost:** \$20.00 per student [+GST]

**Minimum Spend:** \$600

**Best Suited to:** Year 5 – Year 12  
(groups of 30 to 100 students per day)

### Mini-Beasts and Water Bugs

Mini-Beasts are woven through all activities, with a particular focus on butterflies, moths, caterpillars, spiders, and macroinvertebrates (water bugs). Learners will discover unseen worlds by identifying macroinvertebrates from the lakes and use their artistic expression to create mini-beast inspired artworks to take home.

**Duration:** 90 mins – 2 hours

**Cost:** \$18 per student [+GST]

**Minimum Spend:** \$400

**Best Suited to:** Early Years – Year 6  
(groups of 40 to 100 per session)

### Cubby Building

Nature Play SA's cubby building excursion engages learners in a real-world STEM challenges. The combination of nature's timeless environment and the park's historical backdrop creates an ideal platform for collaborative learning, emphasizing cooperation, resilience, and sustainable practices.

**Duration:** 90mins

**Cost:** \$18.00 per student [+GST]

**Minimum Spend:** \$600

**Best Suited to:** Early Years – Year 6  
(groups of up to 50 per session)

### Geocaching

An active adventure where children explore the park's surrounding areas on a high-tech literacy-inspired treasure hunt using GPS navigation technology. Geocaching taps into problem-solving, team-building, and creative-thinking skills while promoting physical activity outdoors.

**Duration:** 90mins

**Cost:** \$18.00 per student [+GST]

**Minimum Spend:** \$400

**Best Suited to:** Early Years – Year 8  
(groups of 30 to 60 students per session)
