The inventor who figures out how to solve puzzles and use tools in surprising ways.

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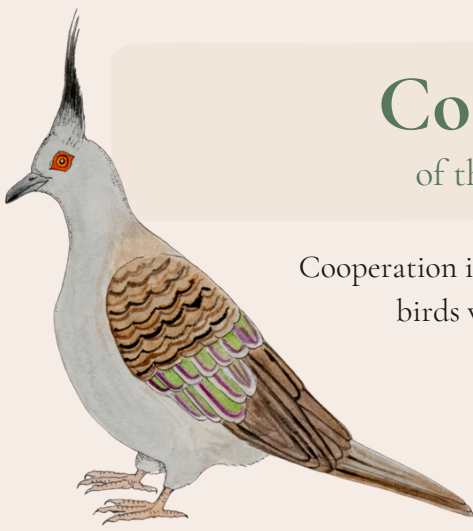
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Cooperative Birds

Cooperation is working well with others and sharing, just like birds who build nests and support each other.



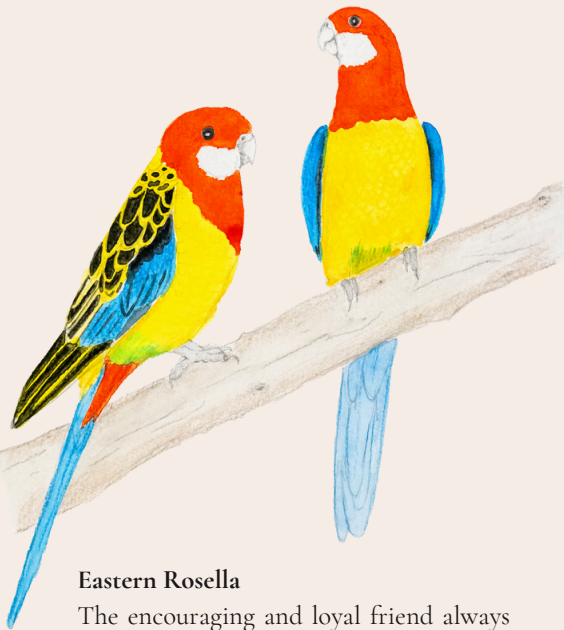
Crested Pigeon

The city adventurer who explores busy places confidences.

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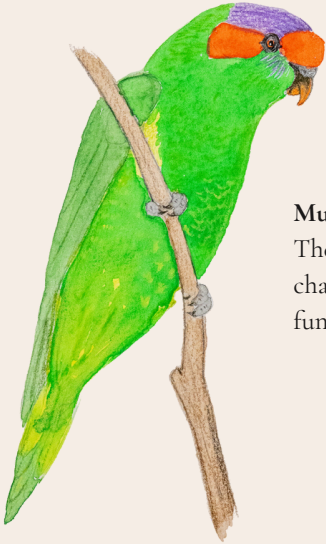
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Playful Birds

The watchful nurturer who stays close to its family, carefully looking out for them and helping guide its chicks as they grow.



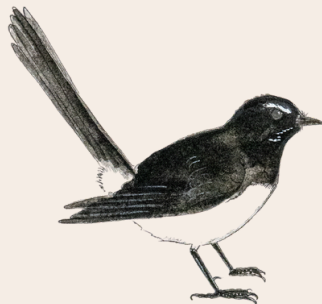
Australian Magpie
